Professor Carsten H. Meyer was trained at the Philipps-University, Marburg, University of Bonn and Federal University of Sao Paulo. Today he is the vitreoretinal surgeon at the Macular Center Graubünden in Chur, Davos. Two decades ago, he started his scientific work on subretinal fluid application for macular translocation in a 2-year fellowship at the Duke Eye Center. He continued his research on innovative treatments of macular holes with vital dyes (chromovitrectomy). In recent years he investigated a novel approach to close large or persisting macular holes by subretinal fluid application. For his contributions he is a recognized international expert in the ranking portal Expertscape.
