

Professor Stanislao Rizzo brilliantly obtained a degree in Medicine and Surgery and the Specialization in Ophthalmology with full marks. Since 1981 he has attended the Ophthalmology Clinic of the University of Florence, carrying out assistance, teaching and research activities. In 1991 he moved to Pisa, where since 2001 he has been in charge of the U.O. complex of Ophthalmic Surgery. Professor Rizzo's activity is accompanied by a rich and intense scientific activity, with numerous publications and awarded with national and international awards. Since 2005 he has also been Director of the Ophthalmology Department at the San Rossore Clinic in Pisa. Since 2020 he has been Director of the Ophthalmology Unit of the Gemelli Polyclinic Foundation, Full Professor of Ophthalmology and Director of the School of Specialization in Ophthalmology at the Catholic University of the Sacred Heart of Rome. Pioneer in artificial retina implants, in 2021 he implanted an artificial retina on a blind patient for the first time in Italy.
