Title of Project: A European Glaucoma Registry: to improve patients' outcomes and research **Purpose:** To establish a European Glaucoma Registry in order to improve patients' outcomes and research in the field of Glaucoma.

Methods: To initiate a European first electronic health record-based comprehensive Glaucoma (imaging and clinical data) and condition registry. It would be a centralized data repository and reporting tool that could analyze Glaucoma patients' data and provide reliable scientific information to improve European public health. Homogeneous dataset could also enable robust European scientific research program in the field of glaucoma imaging and epidemiological studies. We aimed to reproduce at a European level the American IRIS® Registry and the Australian Save Sight Registries.

Conclusion: The SOE European Leadership Development Program provided the skills needed to to initiate this European collaborative project. EuLDP class provided opportunities for networking and strengthening glaucoma research program.
